- In addition to complying with national and international legal and regulatory standards related to the management of chemicals, we are committed to identifying, monitoring, and eliminating potentially harmful chemicals and substances,
- Requesting "Safety Data Sheets" for all purchases and sample procurements, sharing these legally compliant forms with all employees via our document management system, and tracking related activities,
- Listing and classifying all chemical substances and mixtures stored and/or used within the operation in the Chemical Inventory and informing employees and managers accordingly,
- Identifying chemical hazards, analysing risks arising from them, and evaluating alternative methods that are suitable in terms of performance, human health, and environmental risks to reduce these hazards and risks, and taking necessary actions,
- Taking the necessary occupational health and safety precautions to prevent employee exposure to chemicals in areas where chemicals are used, and providing the necessary resources,
- Using all chemicals in compliance with legal regulations and responsibly, while working to gradually phase out the use of various chemicals,
- Conducting efforts to control and monitor situations where chemicals stored in areas under physical conditions such as temperature, pressure, or humidity may degrade and cause health, environmental, and physicochemical risks,
- Committing to periodic employee training on chemical management and conducting drills to ensure preparedness for potential emergencies.

Our goal is to minimize risks related to exposure and hazards during the procurement, transport, storage, use, and disposal of all chemicals, to comply with national and international laws and regulations, and to adopt environmentally conscious and sustainable practices.
